

As you get ready to move into the residence hall, please remember these rules:

- Alcohol/Drugs: Finlandia University is a dry campus. No alcohol or drugs are permitted on campus.
- Cooking/Appliances Guidelines:
  - Hot plates and/or electrical appliances that have exposed hot surfaces are forbidden. Listed below are a few examples:
    - Coffeemakers w/ hot plate warmers
    - George Foreman Grills & Electric Griddles
    - Toasters & Toaster Ovens
    - Fryers, Pizza Ovens, etc.
  - Appliances that are allowed include (All electronic appliances must be UL certified):
    - Microwaves
    - Enclosed Rice Cookers
    - Coffeemakers that do not have hot plate warmers (e.g. pots that hold their own heat – vacuum sealed containers, thermoses, etc.)
    - Electric teapots that have enclosed heating elements.
- Dangerous Materials & Open Flame: Candles, incense, and dangerous chemicals are forbidden in Finlandia Hall.
- Fireworks: Fireworks shall not be used in any campus building or on campus property at anytime.
- External Antennas/Satellite Dishes are not allowed to be mounted outside residence hall rooms.
- Furniture: Finlandia University does not encourage students to bring large pieces of furniture, as the residence hall rooms are limited in space and adequately furnished. Residents will be charged for the removal and disposal of personal furniture left behind.
- Beds: If a student plans to bring their own bed into the residence hall, Finlandia University requires that it be no larger than a double-size bed. The university does not allow the use of waterbed in the residence hall.
- Pets are not allowed in the residence hall. Exception: fish held in a 10-gallon tank or smaller.
- Guns/Rifles/Hunting Accessories: Weapons of any kind are not allowed on campus. However, due to popular area interest in hunting game animals, students who participate in such activities may bring their hunting equipment. All hunting equipment must be registered and stored by the Department of Campus Safety and Security.
