



Request to Reside Off Campus

The university's requirements for on-campus residence are part of the effort to ensure the optimal experience for students. Residence life promotes educational, social, recreational and leadership programs that are considered a key component of the Finlandia experience. Therefore, the university requires that all students live in university residence halls while enrolled for classes except those students who have met at least one of the following criteria (check one):

- Have successfully completed (grade C or better) 48 or more credit hours at an accredited higher education institution after high school graduation
- Are 21 years of age or older on or before the last official day of the semester they are registered for
- Are residing with parent(s), sibling(s) or grandparent(s) within a 60-mile radius of campus
- Are married and/or residing at home with their children
- Have prior or concurrent military service

In order for this request to be considered, the completed form must be returned along with any supporting documentation (transcripts, signed letter from parents verifying residence, etc.). These housing requirements are conditions of enrollment that must be met throughout the academic year. Only in the case of extreme circumstances will exceptions be made to this requirement.
