Position Summary:

The Science Instructor will teach high school-aged youth during a five-week, on-campus summer program to engage students in activities in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math fields to share a passion for science and obtain knowledge in specific science fields to aid them in high school classes.

Required Qualifications:

1. Ability to convey passion for knowledge and an appreciation for chosen topics in science
2. Demonstrated ability to create a positive learning environment and build rapport with high school students
3. Demonstrated ability to create diverse and engaging lessons for high school-age students
4. Show an acceptance of diversity and empathy for youth
5. Demonstrated commitment to the value of education
6. Flexibility in scheduling and classroom setting

Desired Qualifications:

1. State certification as a secondary school instructor
2. 2-4 years experience instructing high school youth

Essential Responsibilities:

1. Teach a five-week class to high school-age youth
 - a. Tentatively Monday through Thursday mornings: 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM from 6/14 to 7/14
2. Complete weekly student progress reports
3. Meet with Program Staff weekly or as needed
4. Adhere to university policies and procedures
5. Work collegially and professionally with students, employees, and external constituents

6. Support institutional identity and mission of Finlandia University as “a learning community dedicated to academic excellence, spiritual growth, and service”
7. Perform other duties as required
