An Exceptionally Busy Summer

It has been an exceptionally busy summer on Finlandia's campus! Most notably, of course, is the election of our new president, Philip Johnson. President Johnson officially began his new responsibilities July 1. For several months prior to July 1 he and retiring President Ubbelohde worked together closely to ensure a smooth transition.

On Thursday, September 20, 2007, a presidential inauguration and installation event will take place on campus. A committee of Board members, faculty, staff, and students is hard at work this summer organizing the full day event. Everyone is welcome. We hope you'll attend.

A Board of Trustees meeting, and the annual meetings of the International Alumni Board and the Finnish Council in America brought many dedicated university supporters and volunteers to campus this summer. Their discussions were lively, especially as the university begins the 2007-08 academic year with a new president and a reorganized Board.

More than 100 students were on campus in June and July for a very well-attended summer semester. Also this summer, a group of 35 area high school students experienced the daily routines of college freshmen, including classes, homework, and dorm living, during Finlandia's annual 6-week Upward Bound "mock college experience."

In June "Fiddlers ReStrung," a group of talented high school musicians, performed an energetic show of bluegrass and traditional music at the Finnish American Heritage Center. The Finlandia University Gallery featured exhibitions by several Finnish-American artists this summer, including environmental artist Cherie Sampson, and Daniel and Tiffany Besonen's sculptural installation *Kotiväki* (Finnish for family). In late July more than 50 youth completed the annual NGLS Lutheran Leadership School, an event hosted at Finlandia for more than 20 years.

Two Elderhostel sessions in July and August found several dozen "seniors" lodging in the dorms, strolling around campus, and learning about Finnish American history and culture. The 9th annual Sibelius Academy Music Festival entertained hundreds of concertgoers with a series of four outstanding performances by a solo pianist, a soprano, and a chamber music trio.

We are pleased to recognize our many supporters in this issue of *the Bridge*. The full-length *Bridge* will be back this winter. In it we'll tell you more about President Johnson, his Management Team, the members of the reorganized Board of Trustees, what's going on on campus, and, most importantly, what Finlandia students are up to this academic year.





FROM THE PRESIDENT



PHILIP JOHNSON

President

"As we talked further about Finlandia, Hancock, and Porvoo, it became clear to all four of us that we share a common challenge: maximizing the contemporary relevance of our history and ethnic heritage."

Finlandia has roots. These roots are ethnic and religious, Finnish and Lutheran. I am Lutheran. I am not Finnish. It wasn't that long ago that Finlandia's constitution would have prevented me from becoming president. The twenty-eight colleges and universities related to the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America all have such roots: Danish, Norwegian, Swedish, German, and so on. Finlandia, however, is the only one in North America planted by Finns.

In July I enjoyed two days with Finlandia's Finnish Council in America. It was my first Finnish Council meeting, and I decided to wear a pin that I received as a guest while visiting friends and relatives in Finland and Norway two summers ago. The pin is two small flags sharing a center pole, one Norwegian, one Finnish. Arriving for breakfast on the first day, one Council member eyed the pin suspiciously and with a smirk asked, "What's that other flag?" He was joking ... I think.

A day before the Finnish Council meeting I was visited by two young leaders from Porvoo, Finland: the mayor, Marcus Henricson, and Mikaela Nylander, a member of Finland's Parliament and chairman of the Porvoo City Council. Both were in town as guests of the City of Hancock. (Porvoo is Hancock's Finnish sister city.) Glenn Anderson, Hancock's city manager, also joined us.

I learned from Markus and Mikaela that, at 700 years old, Porvoo is the second oldest city in Finland. The older sections of Porvoo, they said, continue to attract many tourists from Finland and throughout Europe. But Markus added how important it has become for Porvoo to find new ways to package herself not only as a city rich in history and heritage, but also as contemporary and vital. Mikaela confirmed that it's no longer enough to say, for instance, that a famous poet or artist lived and worked in Porvoo 200 or 300 years ago.

As we talked further about Finlandia, Hancock, and Porvoo, it became clear to all four of us that we share a common challenge: maximizing the contemporary relevance of our history and ethnic heritage. Finlandia's 2007 HLC/NCA self-study report also identified this challenge: "Distinction in history and heritage remains meaningful and therefore influential only when contemporary expressions of these historical traditions are understood and appropriately applied."

Our Finnish and Finnish-American commitments continue to shape Finlandia's approach to higher education. Most recently, I am reminded of Finlandia's annual Sibelius Academy Music Festival, a unique contribution to the performing arts in and around the Copper Country. Additional examples include a Finnish Studies curriculum, degree programs influenced by contemporary Finnish models of education, international study opportunities, and community classes and events hosted by the Finnish American Heritage Center.

As I move forward with both broad strokes and fine tuning, I am committed to strengthening these and related programs. For example, I want Finlandia to become more intentional about exposing students to international study opportunities. I also believe we need to be more deliberate in creating meaningful venues for our Finnish students to share insights about contemporary Finland. New distance learning opportunities with Finnish universities offer exciting possibilities, and discovering new ways to promote contemporary Finland through the Finnish American Heritage Center deserves our attention.

From the name Johnson and a Norwegian flag on my lapel you could correctly guess that my ancestors were hardy northerners, to be sure, but not of the Finnish sort. There is, however, a little known association that I have with Finland. My wife René's grandfather was a Koskela. As a child, René was nicknamed "Little Finn" by the same grandfather. She can trace one-quarter of her ancestry back to the area of Finnmark in Lapland. As a result, she's both hardy and Finnish. I married this one.

Minnie Perttula-Maki (1880–1957) was Suomi College's only woman president, serving from 1922 to 1923. She was born in Lohtaja, Finland, and was a member of the college's first class, graduating in 1904. She continued her education in Chicago, Duluth, and at the University of Helsinki.

Dear Friends of Finlandia,


