Must be highly organized and show commitment to leadership and developing young men both on and off the field.

2. Preference will be given to coaches who have experience in coaching quarterbacks or an offensive skill position at the collegiate level.
3. Preference will be given to the candidate who has demonstrated a proven ability to recruit quality student-athletes who will fit the academic profile of Finlandia's student body.

5. Strong work ethic, integrity and a positive attitude.
6. Strong interpersonal, management and communication skills.
