- Complete at least 30 of the last 36 credits at Finlandia immediately prior to graduation.
- Complete at least 30 credits at the 300/400 level.
- Complete at least 18 credits for the major at Finlandia University.
- Attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.85.
- Attain a minimum grade of B- in Anatomy & Physiology I & II and in all nursing classes (NUR). All other classes require a minimum grade of C.
- All classes can be taken a maximum of 2 times to achieve the required grades for the nursing program.
- Complete at least three Writing Intensive (WI) courses from at least two disciplines. NUR 318 Nursing Research /Statistics is counted as one Writing Intensive course (WI).
