



Resident Arrival Quarantine Policy

When on-campus residential students arrive at Finlandia Hall, they will be tested during the next available testing timeframe. Once they move in, they are to remain quarantined in their room until they are tested and the results are returned; the current plan calls for results to be returned within two business days. If one tests positive, that student will be relocated into isolation for up to 14 days. The roommate will remain quarantined for 4-5 days and will be re-tested. Once their test comes back negative, they are out of quarantine.

On-campus quarantined students awaiting a test or test results may be approved to leave the quarantine space independently or with suitemates *while under the direct supervision of a full time University employee*. In these situations, students are expected to:

- be under the direction of a full-time University employee at all times.
- use **contact journaling** to keep track of any contacts that may occur outside of the employee and suitemates during the leave from quarantine. The expectation is that no additional contact will occur.
- maintain **6 feet of distance** between other individuals at all times.
- wear an appropriate cloth or medical/surgical **face covering** at *all* times.
- refrain from eating outside of the quarantine space, as it requires removal of a face covering.
- continue **conducting symptom self-monitoring** every day.

Due to the importance of testing to mitigate the spread of the virus, it is vital that each student follows the requirements of this interim policy. In the event there is a complaint of alleged noncompliance, Finlandia's Dean of Students will notify the student of the alleged complaint and seek the student's compliance with the interim policy. Should the student choose not to comply (complete the required testing and self-quarantine as directed) then appropriate action(s) will be initiated as outlined in [Finlandia's COVID-19 Student Handbook Addendum](#).
