CCNE is an autonomous agency whose goal is to assess and identify programs that demonstrate effective educational practices to ensure the quality and integrity of baccalaureate and graduate nursing education programs.

Benefits of accreditation include independent, outside assurance that the Finlandia Nursing program graduates nurses who are well-prepared to provide quality nursing care to our community and beyond.

During the accreditation process, CCNE provides the opportunity for program constituents to submit, in writing, comments concerning the Finlandia Nursing program and its value. The CCNE will accept comments from individuals and groups until September 27, 2021.
