- □ All classes can be taken a maximum of 2 times to achieve the required grades for the nursing program.
- □ Complete at least three Writing Intensive (WI) courses from at least two disciplines. NUR 318 Nursing Research /Statistics is counted as one Writing Intensive course (WI).
