Commitment:

Participating in ROTC/Military Science electives during the first two years requires no commitment. After the first two years, students may commit to serve as Army Officers full-time or parttime in a reserve component following graduation.



VALUE

Scholarships cover tuition, lab fees, and books for three to four years plus tax-free living stipend of \$420 for 10 months. Additional on-campus scholarships are available for two, two-and-a-half, and three years.

BENEFITS

Enhance your leadership and communication skills, get into good physical condition, and receive academic mentor support from a cadet in your major (nearly 70 percent of our cadets make the Dean's list).

LEADER DEVELOPMENT

First-year students spend seven hours per week on Army ROTC activities, including three hours on physical training, two hours in Leadership Lab, one hour in the classroom, and one hour in academic mentorship meetings. Other volunteer activities include the Ranger Challenge Team, Ranger Buddy Team, Cannon Crew, and Color Guard.
